

MARYLAND TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION POLICE ENHANCES CAPABILITY WITH TACTICAL-IP™ SATELLITE SERVICE

MTA also will utilize Tactical-Voice™, Incident Communications voice-over-IP solution. Tactical-Voice uses any available means to connect users to the Tactical-Voice network (i.e. DSL, Cable, Satellite) giving the agency voice service in any situation.

The MTA Police provides law enforcement of the transit networks throughout Maryland. The Transit Police have the unique challenge of enforcing the law on all five modes of transportation in the State of Maryland: Bus, Metro, Light-Rail, ParaTransit, and Commuter Rail (MARC).
