

ICS RETROFITS RICHMOND POLICE DEPARTMENT MOBILE COMMAND UNIT

STEVENSVILLE, Md. - Incident Communication Solutions (ICS) has recently retrofitted the Richmond (VA) Police Department's Mobile Command Unit (MCU) to provide the agency with greater communication capabilities and access.

Richmond Police Department (RPD) took delivery of their MCU which was fully integrated by ICS to include satellite connectivity, advanced IP Networking, and various other types of communications. A TracStar .75 meter satellite dish was installed to provide the vehicle with greater broadband VSAT access speed and improving overall connectivity.
